9 MONTH, 2 YEAR AND 3-4 YEAR OLD FUNDING AT THE LITTLE TUG BOAT DAY NURSERY

Please also refer to the Nursery's General Terms & Conditions

- The Nursery offers full day sessions from 8am -6.30pm and requires a minimum attendance of 2 days for all children. All places must be taken with a Monday or Friday.
- Government funding is not intended to cover the full cost of your child's place at Nursery. Little Tug Boat charges a monthly fee to cover an "Additional Services Package" as detailed below.
- The offer is based on 38 weeks per year, and as a provider of year round childcare, the funding is stretched across 51 weeks. Therefore 15 hours funding is stretched to give 11.18 hours per week and 30 hours funding is stretched to give 22.35 hours per week. The remaining non-funded hours are charged for as part of the Nursery's Additional Services Fees Package
- For children attending 2 days per week, funding entitlement is capped at 11.18 hours per week. In order to access the full 30 hour entitlement, a minimum of 3 days attendance is required.
- Funded places are limited and subject to Nursery availability

WORKING PARENT ENTITLEMENT - 15 & 30 HOURS FUNDING FOR CHILDREN AGED 9 MONTHS – 3 YEARS OLD

- The Little Tug Boat is registered with the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham to offer the Working Parent Entitlement funding for 15 hours or 30 hours, per eligible child per week
- The offer is based on 38 weeks per year, and as a provider of year round childcare, the funding is stretched across 51 weeks
 - 15 hours x 38 weeks funding is stretched over 51 weeks = 11.18 hours per week. This is applied over a minimum 2 days per week with additional non-funded hours charged for as part of the Nursery's Additional Services Fees Package
 - 30 hours x 38 weeks funding is stretched over 51 weeks = 22.35 hours per week. This is applied over a minimum 3 days per week with additional non-funded hours charged for as part of the Nursery's Additional Services Fees Package
- Full fees are charged until a child becomes eligible to claim the Working Parent Entitlement funding, the term after the child turns 9 months and then 2 years old

- If parents are successful they will be provided with an eligibility code. This must be provided in writing to the Nursery Manager, along with a fully completed and signed parental declaration form. Funding will only be applied to fees once these have been provided to the Nursery Manager
- Funding will only be applied to fees once a valid eligibility code and fully completed parental declaration form has been provided to the Nursery Manager
- Parents are responsible for re-applying/ re-confirming their eligibility for the 15 and 30 hour funding every 3 months.
- Please note the Local Authority and Tug Boat have no role in the application process; parents/ carers will need to contact HMRC directly to resolve any issues

UNIVERSAL 3-4 YEAR OLD FUNDING

- The Little Tug Boat is registered with the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham to offer universal free places of up to 15 hours (per eligible child) per week for 3-4 year olds
- The offer is based on 38 weeks per year, and as a provider of year round childcare, the funding is stretched across 51 weeks
 - 15 hours x 38 weeks funding is stretched over 51 weeks = 11.18 hours per week. This is applied over a minimum 2 days per week with additional non-funded hours charged for as part of the Nursery's Additional Services Fees Package

- Full fees are charged until a child becomes eligible to claim the universal free place, the term after they turn three years old
- The Nursery's Additional Services Package is optional. Please speak with the Nursery Manager before a funded place is accepted if you wish to opt out. Please note that it may be possible to access a completely free offer at another provider.

UNIVERSAL 3-4 YEAR OLD FUNDING + EXTENDED 15 HOURS ENTITLEMENT (30 hours)

- The Little Tug Boat is registered with the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham to offer the universal free place plus extended 15 hours entitlement (per eligible child) per week for eligible 3-4 year olds
- The offer is based on 38 weeks per year, and as a provider of year round childcare, the funding is stretched across 51 weeks
 - 30 hours x 38 weeks funding is stretched over 51 weeks = 22.35 hours per week. This is applied over a minimum 3 days per week with additional non-funded hours charged for as part of the Nursery's Additional Services Fees Package
- Full fees are charged until a child becomes eligible to claim the entitlement, the term after they turn three years old.
- Parents need to apply at <https://childcaresupport.tax.service.gov.uk/par/app/applynow>
- If parents are successful they will be provided with an eligibility code. This must be provided in writing to the Nursery Manager, along with a fully completed and signed parental declaration form. Funding will only be applied to fees once these have been provided to the Nursery Manager
- Funding will only be applied to fees once a valid eligibility code and fully completed parental declaration form has been provided to the Nursery Manager

ADDITIONAL SERVICES PACKAGE

Government funding is not intended to cover the full cost of your child's place at Nursery. The Nursery's additional services fee covers items including, but not limited to:-

- Extended opening hours of 8am – 6.30pm, 51 weeks of the year
- 3 meals (breakfast, lunch and tea), 1 snack and organic milk, prepared by the Nursery Chef using organic meat, milk and yoghurt
- An enriched curriculum which includes a variety of classes and teaching pedagogues including Spanish, Sports and Sign & Rhyme. Plus Nursery parties and events.
- Consumables such as nappy creams and sun cream

Tug Boat Nursery Funding in Practice

As a Nursery which is open for 51 weeks per year, the Nursery stretches 38 week funding x 15 or 30 hours across the full year. The Nursery provides a full fee breakdown to parents.
